

Son of top Hamas leader becomes Christian

The son of Sheik Hassan Yousef, one of the top leaders in the Palestinian terrorist organization Hamas, has announced that he has become a [Christian](#). Maybe one day I'll be able to return to Palestine and to Ramallah with Jesus, in the Kingdom of God."*
