

Palestinian maps erase Israel even after UN bid

Palestinian Media Watch has revealed that the day following Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas' [impassioned plea](#) before the United Nations General Assembly, calling for international recognition of a Palestinian state in accordance with the 'two state solution', PA Television were broadcasting promotional images in support of the UN bid showing maps of the Middle East with the state of Israel nowhere to be seen. It is of course not the first time that this has happened. Shortly following Abbas' speech at the commencement of the [Annapolis peace process](#) in 2007, PA TV broadcast graphics showing a [Palestinian state](#) comprising all of the territory now possessed by Israel. Perhaps in 2007 this might not have been such a serious issue. There was no threat of a Palestinian state being established without a peaceful solution being reached. But with no peace agreement in sight, and the Palestinian Authority now demanding that the world give them a state, it has become a very serious issue indeed.

Quote: *“The day after PA Chairman Abbas delivered the Palestinian Authority's request for statehood to the UN, PA TV, which is controlled directly by Abbas' office, broadcast a map that erases Israel and envisions Palestinian sovereignty over all of Israel.*

The map includes both the PA areas and all of Israel (excluding the Golan Heights) wrapped in the Palestinian flag - a symbol of Palestinian sovereignty over the whole area - and has a key through it, symbolizing ownership.
