# Manchester first city to trial ID cards

The Labour government is pressing ahead with plans to implement a national identity card system, with a new trial that is to be launched in Manchester city. The ID card, which was first proposed by former Labour Home Secretary David Blunkett, has faced calls to be scrapped as Britain faces its deepest recession in over 70 years. Ironically, David Blunkett himself is one of those who are now calling for the card to be axed, and replaced by a cheaper biometric passport system.
