Quote: "The chief executive of HFEA, Angela McNabb, says the legal and ethical pros and cons were weighed very carefully. "We've been able to weigh those up and take what's a very strong decision where we're saying we can move forward with cytoplasmic hybrid embryos and the creation of those in some research, so we can gain the potent benefits but only in the framework of very strong regulation, " McNabb says.
