

Gaddafi meeting Mubarak over PA government

Egyptian President Hosni Mubarak is meeting with Colonel Muammar [Gaddafi](#) of Libya tomorrow to discuss a range of issues affecting the region. On the agenda will be the escalating crisis in neighbouring Sudan, along with Iraq, Lebanon, the issue of the new Palestinian unity government and increased ties between the two countries. Libya, at least to me, seems an unlikely country to become embroiled in the peace process in the Middle East. But Gaddafi is a strong supporter of the Hamas terror government, and has officially pledged his [su](#)
